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Expansion of the Toll Station on AmberOne A1 Motorway

As a result of increasing traffic and in view of the comfort of travel on AmberOne Motorway A1, work has begun on the reconstruction of the Toll Station in Nowa Wieś aimed at increasing its capacity by building additional 2 exit lanes.

In addition to automatic payments introduced at toll plazas in 2019, it is a basic form of improving the passage through the gates. . Construction is already underway and GTC and Intertoll are working to ensure that the new toll gates added to the site are in place from the beginning of 2022.

The work will be carried out in such a way that it is not burdensome for drivers, but the need to temporarily close individual gates cannot be ruled out.

Currently, there are 4 entry lanes and 8 exit lanes on the PPO in Nowa Wieś. The new exit gates will increase the number of gates to 10, which will make the capacity of the PPO Nowa Wieś at the exit equal to the capacity of the PPO Rusocin.

It is worth noting that PPO Rusocin, thanks to the growing interest in automatic payments AmberGO only occasionally faces problems resulting from the traffic congestion. Currently, PPO Rusocin with automatic payments AmberGO is able to handle up to 2000 vehicles per hour (with mixed traffic on all lanes due to plaza congestion, in case more drivers would use AmberGO, more lanes could be dedicated to AmberGO at all times resulting in significantly increased capacity and reduced queuing).

The expansion of PPO Nowa Wieś will also make even more efficient use of the existing two reversable gates, which will allow to use 5 or even 6 entry lanes instead of 4 more often, this will increase the capacity of the entry gates from 1200 to more than 1800 vehicles per hour helping to reduce queues at peak times.
